Following guidance due to Coronavirus COVID-19, we have had to make temporary changes to our service.

Extended telephone hours service

The 0-19 Service are still very much here to support the health and wellbeing of everyone in your family.

Any child, young person, parent, or carer can call Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm, on **01924 310130** for advice and support.

We will continue to provide the following:

- **Antenatal contact**

By telephone or video call but sometimes may be in person.



- **Birth contact**

By telephone or video call but sometimes may be in person.



- **Additional support for children, young people, and their families to meet their individual needs**

By telephone, video call, or in person where required.



- **Ongoing support for those known to services**

By telephone, video call, or in person where required.



- **Emotional support for young people**

By telephone or video call, or in person where required.



- **Vaccinations and Immunisations for children**

Children aged 0-5 years will receive contact from their GP. Children aged 5-19 years will receive contact from the team if their immunisation is due. The team can be contacted on **01924 310133**.

The following will be stopped:

- Routine development reviews (6-8 week, 12-16 week, 9-12 month, and 2-2.5 year)
- School screening and drop-in clinics
- Packages of care such as bed wetting and behavioural support
